## **Erin Hall- Rep/Travel Director**

- In January we selected coaches. They were announced online to our members.
- Coaching clinics will be announced this week.
- Here are the 2023 requirements for coaches:
  - Coaches must be properly NCCP-certified for the age division that they are coaching.
  - Coaches must be properly registered with the OLA through Sportzsoft.
  - Bench personnel over the age of 18 must complete their screening requirements according to the OLA's Screening Policy.
  - o Teams must also have a prepared <u>emergency action plan</u> that is accessible at any event that they are participating in.
- I also followed up with the Toronto Rock about our Highlanders night. It seems that now they require the association (or someone) to purchase a bulk quantity of tickets in advance. I did provide feedback that doing it this way makes it an unattainable event for

the smaller centres. Without doing it this way they will not provide us with any of the experiences or the "storefront" which allows us to share the link and families to purchase.

- We've had a few questions regarding CMLA lending the money for tournaments to the teams so that coaches are not waiting until teams are formed to be reimbursed.
- Also questions wondering if we have blocked provincials hotels for CMLA teams as last year there was difficulty securing hotels. If this is something we would like to do I can start looking into it. Board agrees that it's up to you!
